

## What is the Professional Case Analysis & Planning Program?

This program has been designed specifically for JSA providers working with job seekers with multiple non-vocational barriers. The program gives JSA providers access to a registered psychologist who will work with them 1-on-1 and in small groups to review specific case files and provide suggestions and strategies for future support and intervention with their job seekers.

Learn how to better service your job seekers and more effectively address their serious, and sometimes multiple, non-vocational barriers to employment. The Professional Case Analysis & Planning Program is conducted at your site, at a time that suits you.

## Who Makes a Suitable Case Analysis Client?

- Stream 4 participants
- Job seekers with significant non-vocational barriers
- Job seekers you are having difficulty in “moving forward”
- Job seekers who are avoiding “disclosure” of their barriers
- Job seekers you are having trouble motivating



## The Process

- STEP 1 : Identify suitable cases for analysis
- STEP 2 : Provide brief case overview prior to session
- STEP 3 : Attend session with registered psychologist (1-on-1 or Group\*)
- STEP 4 : Receive individual case assistance/ideas/strategies with registered psychologist

## Costs/Rates

### 1-on-1 Case Analysis & Planning

Registered psychologist works with an individual case manager/consultant on specific cases, summary report provided for all cases (min 3 cases)

\$250+GST per case analysis

### Group Based Case Analysis & Planning

Registered psychologist works with a group of case managers/consultants on specific cases, summary report provided for all cases.

1-day session (Max 7 cases) \$1400+GST

1/2-day session (Max 4 cases) \$800+GST
